# FAQs on the WFPI

## Can I become a member of WFPI as an individual pediatric radiologist?

This is not possible under our current bylaws. Only pediatric radiology societies or subgroups can join, bringing their individual members in with them. However, we are planning on a bylaws amendment to extend membership to non-pediatric radiologists, radiographers and clinicians. So.... stay posted!

### Does the WFPI just do developing country work?

No. Our tele-reading, training and education offered in lower resources settings is an important part of our work, but not the only one. #### Where is the WFPI based?

We do not have our own fixed base as yet. We are currently run as an offshoot of the Society for Pediatric Radiology (North American) but we will have to incorporate, i.e. exist in own right, soon. Wherever we incorporate in the world, however, it does not mean that the WFPI will adopt this country's nationality. Incorporation is an administrative step; the spirit, governing Council and membership of the WFPI will remain firmly international. Our staff is based in Europe while our Council members hail from all over the world (19 hours time difference between the two furthest apart!). The WFPI is managed almost exclusively through online communication, with "live" physical and remote meetings set up when the opportunity presents.
