

WFPI Observership Application – the Philippines

Introduction:

WFPI is offering a three-month sponsored training program to be spent at the St. Luke's Medical Center, Quezon City and Global City, Philippines under the mentorship of Professor Bernard F. Laya, MD, DO along with the St. Luke's Medical Center Pediatric Radiology Team.

This program offers \$3,000 US to cover transport and living expenses.

The program aims to enhance the clinical practice and teaching of pediatric radiology at all levels of healthcare more broadly in the region, by developing expertise in imaging techniques and familiarity with protocols appropriate to the regions's burden of childhood disease. The program is designed to complement and expand basic specialist training in diagnostic radiology. The outcome will be detailed knowledge and in-depth experience of paediatric imaging in the local context. The knowledge and skills acquired will empower a radiologist to conduct optimal pediatric imaging in either a general radiology service or a dedicated pediatric service.
