# Questions for suggested WFPI projects: outreach and training

## Clinical Hospital of Tetovo, Macedonia

#### Background-justification for facility-based projects

- 1. Does it involve a private or MoH facility? How does it fit into the national health system? Answer: Clinical Hospital of Tetovo is MoH facility. Services at the CHT are covered by the Public Health Insurance
- 2. What are the facility's future plans for meeting imaging needs? Supporting onsite radiologists and clinicians with WFPI tele-reading pediatric imaging expertise will have a limited lifespan— are there plans for more sustainable services?

  Answer: So far there haven't been any plans regarding the teleconsulting, however our hospital is happy to pursue the cooperation with the WFPI on this direction.
- 3. How many pediatric beds, what is the patient load?

  Answer: Around 100 pediatric beds with a 60-80 % patients load.
- 4. Staffing: what radiology teams are in place? Are numbers sufficient? Current standards? Future training options? Supervision? Staff presence? Particular constraints?

  Answer: At the Department of Radiology of CHT are working 8 General Radiologists.
- 5. Is patient care affordable? (fee system?)

  Answer: Patient care is affordable and covered 90 % by Health Insurance and 10 % by the patient.
- 6. Is infrastructure adequate? Power? Internet band width, server reliability?

  Answer: Infrastructure is not yet at the desired level, however there is Power and Internet Supply and computers available.
- 7. Are supply lines secured for medical materials and spare parts?

  Answer: Yes
- 8. Is equipment sufficiently maintained?

Answer: Yes

### **Tele-reporting**

- 1. Are there existing active sites imaging children? Answer: No
- 2. Are these sites digital?

Answer: Yes

3. Is there a telereporting system already in place? If yes, can we offer our volunteers to that system and what do we need to certify?

Answer: No, there is no telereporting system installed at Radiology Department of the Clinical Hospital of Tetovo.
