Also, a request to have the subject of the webinar and offer webinars that are in English and in Spanish.

- Digital Education Programme and Committee – Sanjay Prabhu and Joanna Brown
 - Joanna shared that Hansel Otero, Taylor Chung and Sanjay Prabhu will work with the Representative Directors to get a list of volunteers to participate on the committee. There was a recommendation of 3 volunteers from each Representative Director and members society.

3/ Committee Updates

- Outreach Committee – Hansel Otero (HO): Gave the following updates
 - They haven't been doing much outreach in person due to COVID 19. They still offer the teleradiology services. Anyone can submit a case from an iPhone. They

are helping to support the Education committee. They are still getting together with colleagues to share case.

- MRI Protocol Committee - Michael Gee (MG): Michael Gee invited Dr. Camilo Jaimes to the meeting to report on the committee's collaboration with SLARP.
 - Dr. Jaimes shared his slides regarding the Network for MRI teaching in Latin America. The organizers of this collaboration are Camillo Jaimes, Michael Gee and Jose Lipsich. The institutions, organizations and committees represented are the MRI Protocol Committee, Boston Children's Hospital, Massachusetts General Hospital, SLARP, and Garrahan Children's Hospital.
- Digital Education Committee - Sanjay Prabhu (SP): Sanjay provided the majority of his report above. In addition, he mentioned that if anyone has a recommendation for members please send the information to Jennifer, Joanna and Sanjay.
